Wednesday 7 th June	Year 3 teachers will observe the children in class and during break at the infants.
Wednesday 21 st June KEJS Sports Week	Year 2 & 3 get together on KEJS field for 30 minutes of sporting activities together.
Monday 26 th June	Letter goes out to all parents about classes and teachers for September. Separate 1:1 transition from infants.
Tuesday 27 th June	Transition to new class (Bump up days) Year 2 & 3 teachers to do a 'getting to know you task' with the children at the Junior School in their new classes. Year 2 & 3 teachers take the children on a tour of the junior school and have break with the Year 3 children. They will also have lunch in the hall with the Year 3 children before going back to the infants.
Thursday 4 th July	Year 2 parents information meeting (3:15pm – 4:00pm)

Please note, you will be informed directly of any extra transitions activities for your child if they have been identified as needing extra support.
