


Help to prepare the Library Computer at the start of the day. It must be switched-on and logged into Junior Librarian. Please follow the instructions on the Library Desk.




Computer Log-On Details

- We have a wide-range of books at the KEJS Library. They must always be scanned using the Library Computer.
 - Fiction These story books and are arranged in alphabetical order by the author's surname. E.g. Guy Bass is kept above the letter B.
 - Information They are fact books about real-life topics! These are organized by the Dewey Number on their spines. E.g. Animals will be above the 590 label on the shelf.
 - Picture Books Illustrated books for older readers. These are found in the Picture Book Area.
 - First/Next Steps Books for newly independent readers. They have one or two black-lines on their spines.
 - Speedy Reads Fun and fast-paced books, great if you're not sure what to borrow next.
 - T Fiction These are older reads and can only be borrowed by the children in Year Six.
