#### Art

In Art we are studying a range of ways to create our own sculptures. We will be using wire, clay and tin foil to create a different sculpture each week.

#### Science

Our Science Topic is 'All living things and their habitats'. We will be looking at how we effect our environment and the living things inside of it. As we progress through our topic, we will also classify a range of living things using a dichotomous key.

## Maths

This term we will begin with learning how to decode Roman Numerals. This will help our understanding of place value, addition and subtraction. We will also learn about how Roman Numerals link to the real world and when they can be used. Also this term we will cover a range of skills previously learned in preparation for Year 5.

# Living Things and Habitats — Summer 2



### Writing

For Summer 2, we are writing a setting description based on the story 'The Promise' by Nicola Davies, a picture book depicting environmental change. We will be using a range of adjectives and emotive language to bring the setting of the story to life.

# Reading

In reading workshop, we are having a closer look at 'the Water Horse'. We will be analysing the language used by the author as well as taking the opportunity to enjoy the novel.

# PE

We have two focus sports this term: variety rounders and athletics. In variety rounders, we will learn a range of sending and receiving skills before having the opportunity to select equipment to either support or challenge children. In athletics, we will be learning skills in preparation for our exciting Sports' Week.

## RE

Our Religious Education studies will centre upon the theme of how stones are used as symbols in Christianity. This will build on knowledge of what symbols are and what they might mean to us.

# ICT

In our new project, we'll learn how to create our own adventure game world with multiple levels to explore. We will learn how to use conditional selection to react to key presses and add variables to store a game's state.

### PSHE

This term, we will be learning about 'Growing and changing', which includes subjects like moving house. In our learning, we will describe some of the changes that happen to people during their lives and explain how the Learning Line can be used as a tool to help them manage change more easily.
