# **History**

Whilst learning about the Ancient Greeks, the students will discover who the Ancient Greek people were, when they lived and where and how they were able to establish their empire. We will also focus on how the political system worked in Ancient Greece, investigate the legacy of Athenian Democracy and compare it with the political systems we have today. In addition, the children also compare and contrast the modern-day Olympics with the Ancient Greek events.

#### **Science**

With a focus on the properties of materials, children will be able to give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials including metals, wood and plastics.

#### Music

Children will to learn and play a variety of different instruments as part of Hampshire Music Service's Listen 2 Me program.

#### **French**

The children will be following a unit called "All around my house and home".

#### RE

Peace in the context of the Muslim faith.

#### **MATHS**

This term we will continue to develop our understanding of place value. We will then move onto the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). We will also be looking at comparing and ordering fractions.
