

## Science

Children will understand that materials can be changed by heating, cooling, mixing with other materials and whether these are reversible or irreversible changes.

## History

The children will be continuing their learning about the Ancient Greeks. Children will compare and contrast the modern day Olympics with the Ancient Greek events.

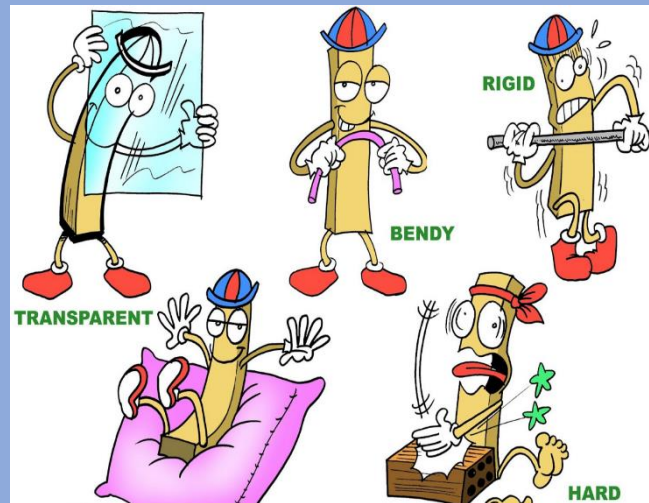
# Mysterious Materials! Year 5 Spring 2 2023
