

ENGLISH

With SATs approaching Year 6 will continue to develop, practise and apply their reading skills. They'll be looking at a variety of rich texts with a focus on building their fluency, vocabulary and answering techniques.

This term the children will be creating a variety of written work inspired by *The Dam* by David Almond. We will be moving towards a more independent writing approach as we are now more than half way through year 6.

DT and ART

MUSIC
